CAST PRODUCTION ASSISTANT NOTES

While I'm writing this, we're about two weeks away from tech. We're doing brush-up choreography rehearsals. Tomorrow we're running Act I with no line call for the first time. The set is starting to take shape. There are still ticket forms that need to be turned in and costumes to make and hundreds of things to tweak with the show. It still seems impossible that opening night is in less than a month. We're at the point when it seems like we'll be rehearsing forever, but I know we won't. You, reading the program while you wait for the show to start, are the proof. How fast did it all go by? Did it really all come together in time? I hope you like it. You won't see the hours we put into it. You're only seeing the end.

Sometimes it's hard to understand why we do theatre. We rehearse and build and sew for months. We focus all our energy on creating a show and making it perfect, and then it happens and it's done. So why do we do it? Is it for the audience? Is it for the end product or the process? Maybe it's for when they both come together on opening night, for that fleeting endpoint that makes it all worth it.

While you're reading this, I'm probably up in the booth. There's that loud-but-hushed feeling that sets over an audience before a show starts. The curtain is closed. The lights are still on. In a few minutes they'll go off and the curtain will open and the show will start.

Right now, in the past, I'm not sure how we'll get this show done. How all the lines will be memorized and the set finished and the costumes done, and how I'll remember to play every sound cue. But I do know that if you look up at the booth right now, I will be looking down and thinking that it is very much worth it right now.

I hope you enjoy the show.

TECH CREW PRODUCTION ASSISTANT NOTES

There is much more that happens behind the scenes than what meets the eye. At the moment you're probably reading this, there are dozens of teenagers scrambling backstage to make sure that everything is in its place. There are actors trying to get their costumes on, crew trying to make sure that the stage is set, and makeup being frantically applied. We are all among those kids.

There are weeks of preparation and commitment that go into creating every show, but none it would have been possible without the help and guidance from our directors. Without Mr. Kastner, the only set we would have would be boxes of cardboard, adorned with Crayola paint from Michaels. The directors are who keep us organized while we work through the couple of months *Newsies* takes to create, and words cannot express how thankful we are for them.

Every day in Tech Crew we're creating something new. We're drilling, painting, tying knots and so much more. We start working and we don't stop, you are seeing the result of that. The amount of commitment the company members show is incredible. Tech kids work every week after school and occasionally come in on Saturdays to help build the set, actors work five days a week trying to memorize hundreds of lines and the members of Costume Crew spend hours sewing costumes and making props. All of these people go into the creation of our headline.

From all the planning the directors do months in advance, to the splinters Tech Crew has had to pull out. From all the pins that Costume Crew has poked themselves with, to the botched lines that the cast has worked to correct, the sweat and time spent working every day have all been entirely worth it. We are extremely grateful for everyone who has helped produce this show, and we are proud to present Wydown's production of *Newsies*.
